



## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

### As a parent/guardian you are expected to:

- Encourage your daughter(s) to learn the rules and play within them;
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials;
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results;
- Never force your daughter to take part;
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all players;
- Never punish or belittle a youngster for losing or making mistakes;
- Support your daughter's involvement and help her to enjoy netball;
- Use correct and proper language at all times;
- Make positive and encouraging comments during the game;
- Respect the coaches and officials and publicly accept their decisions;
- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by refraining from using inappropriate language and respecting umpires and coaches decisions;
- Follow the appropriate procedure in order to question decisions and teach the players to do the same;
- No parent should be present courtside during training except for the team manager;
- No parent should be present courtside at fixtures, with the exception of the team manager, one scorer, one timekeeper and a primary carer where necessary.

### Please note:

- We are only allowed on the school site in the Sports Hall building or on the outside courts, but under no circumstances should anyone use the fitness suite or other facilities.
- Parking is restricted to the car park adjacent to the Sports Hall and cars should not be left elsewhere on the site.
- No parents should be wandering around any other part of the school site, as there are boarders present at all times and this causes issues with the school safeguarding policies.
- Please also remember and adhere to the speed limit throughout the school site of **5mph**.
- Please pick your daughter up from the Sports Hall at the end of her training session.
- Please do not drop your daughter at training without confirming that a coach is there.
